ReMode is a not-for-profit Community Interest Company, and we would not be the same without our hugely talented team of volunteers. Our mission is to raise awareness of the environmental impact of the fashion and textile industries, and work with our community to deliver practical solutions and share positive steps to reduce these impacts.

Our volunteers help us operate through various tasks and roles, including sewing and garment making, events organisation, marketing and digital media, and general day-to-day running of a small community organisation. Use your existing skills or learn new ones to do your bit for the environment and save clothes and fabrics from landfill!

Time Commitment

- Group volunteering sessions take place weekly, with opportunities to work from home in your own time, allowing for greater flexibility

- Individual volunteering opportunities and times can be arranged with the volunteer coordinator.

Expenses

- We don't want any of our volunteers to be out of pocket for working with us
 - Travel expenses (e.g. bus and train tickets) can be reimbursed for getting to and from volunteering events
 - Meals can be provided for longer volunteering sessions
 - We also keep a well stocked supply of snacks and refreshments readily available at all volunteering opportunities!

We have three main teams of volunteers; **Makers**, **Events** and **Digital**. You can contribute and access volunteering opportunities across as many of them as you would like to - there is no need to stick to just one!

Maker Volunteers

Help ReMode utilise our textile donations and turn them back into useful items! Our team of makers sew, upcycle, mend and create beautiful garments and accessories, which are then sold at our pop-up events and on our online shop. As a non-profit organisation, any income generated from the sales of volunteer-made products will only ever be used to continue the running of ReMode activities which benefit the local community and our volunteers. A basic knowledge of sew machines and hand sewing is advised, although training is provided.

Tasks include:

- Mending and upcycling donated garments
- Creating ReMode Collection garments and accessories using repurposed materials
- General studio maintenance
- Helping to organise our materials storage
- Iron and steaming garments to prepare them for sale

Event Volunteers

Assist in the planning and delivery of ReMode pop-ups and special events including clothes swaps, fashion shows, public performances, workshops, and more! Events planning experience isn't necessary, we want to hear from enthusiastic and organised people from all backgrounds!

Tasks include:

- Collaborating on ideas for ReMode events and activities
- Researching venues in the local community
- Planning and delivering event activities
- Welcome guests and work front-of-house at public events
- Operate our stall at markets - handling transactions and providing excellent customer service

Do you have other skills to offer? On top of our core team, we're always looking for volunteers to help out at our big events in any way they can. Can you provide make-up and hair artistry for performances? Want to document our event through film and photography? Previous experience would be beneficial depending on your area of interest, but whatever your skill is we will try to accommodate you!

Digital Volunteers

We're looking for creative thinkers to help us design beautiful imagery and captivating content for our online presence on social media and our website. Collaborate with the Events team to promote any upcoming events, and with the Makers team to share their creations with our online audience! Interest and experience in marketing, design or photography is desirable but not necessary as training and guidance is provided.

Tasks include:

- Writing blogs for our website
- Designing graphics and videos to be used across our digital platforms
- Help to plan our social media posting calendar
- Take photographs at ReMode events and workshops

- Photograph ReMode Collection garments and make listings on our online shop
