The Creative Assistant will support the delivery of **Hidden Threads**, a programme of workshops and events for young people. Hidden Threads focuses on skills in working with textiles of all kinds, community events, podcasting and zine-making.

Role Overview – Creative Assistant

The Creative Assistant will work closely with ReMode staff and freelance facilitators to support the smooth running of Hidden Threads workshops and related activities. This is a hands-on, practical role which combines workshop support, documentation, and creative digital content.

Key Duties and Responsibilities

- Providing practical support for workshops, including:
 - o Preparing materials and equipment
 - Setting up the workshop space
 - Clearing away at the end of sessions
 - Assisting the facilitator and participants as required
- Documenting workshops, including:
 - Taking registers
 - Taking photos and short video clips (where consent is given)
 - Collating information for ReMode's evaluation and monitoring programme
- **Helping to create digital content** for ReMode's social media and communications, in line with our values and brand.
- Adhering to ReMode's policies, including:
 - Health & Safety
 - Child Protection and Safeguarding
 - Equality, Diversity and Inclusion

Data Protection and GDPR (when handling registers, photos, etc.)

The successful candidate will be required to register with **Disclosure Scotland's PVG Scheme** for work with children and young people.

Essential Skills & Qualities

Personable:

 Good communication skills and the ability to work supportively with young people and other team members.

Engaged:

- An interest in the making and sustainable use of textiles.
- An interest in environmental and climate justice issues.

Organised and reliable:

- Able to arrive prepared and on time for workshops.
- o Able to follow instructions and complete agreed tasks independently.

Desirable Skills & Experience

This role would suit someone who is looking to gain part-time experience in creative, sustainability-focused work with young people.

Experience in one or more of the following areas would be an advantage (but not essential – training and support can be provided):

- Hand and/or machine sewing (garments or textiles)
- Embroidery or other textile embellishment
- Printmaking techniques (e.g. screen print, block print)
- Knitting or crochet
- Film, podcasting or audio recording
- Zine-making or other DIY publishing
- Social media content creation

Job Details

Hours:

- Minimum of 8 hours per week, usually delivered as two 4-hour shifts.
- Weekday afternoons or evenings between 13:00 and 21:00, most often on a Monday, Tuesday or Wednesday.
- Shifts will be confirmed a minimum of 4 weeks in advance.
- Occasional additional shifts during the week or at weekends may be offered throughout the year, depending on programme needs.

Programme dates:

Hidden Threads workshops will run from January 2026 to July 2027.

Fee:

- £13.80 per hour, with a guaranteed minimum of 8 hours per week.
- A monthly timesheet will be required.

Place of work:

 Primarily at ReMode's office and workshop space in the Witherspoon Building, Storie Street, Paisley.

- Occasional work at other local venues in Paisley & Renfrewshire as part of our Education & Outreach programme.
- Travel to working locations other than the ReMode office will be provided or reimbursed by ReMode where necessary.
- Reporting to:
 - ReMode Project Manager and Project Coordinator.
- Safeguarding:
 - The successful candidate will be required to join Disclosure Scotland's PVG Scheme (children and young people).
